Superfast Summer!

The Connecting Cheshire Superfast fibre broadband roll-out has not slowed down over the summer with many more communities now able to enjoy the benefits of life in the fast lane.

Recent switch-on events have taken place in Poynton, Sandiway, Widnes, Tarporley, and Saughall, bringing the total number of premises reached across Cheshire to over 31,000. Local Councillor Eveleigh Moore Dutton, who represents Tarporley, said: "The roll-out is already making a big impact. Many homes and businesses are now taking advantage of the opportunity to upgrade to fibre broadband and seeing how it can bring significant social and economic benefits - and in many cases see a reduction in their costs as broadband charges are falling all the time."

The Government also recently announced that more than one million UK homes and businesses now have access to superfast broadband as a result of the UK wide fibre rollout.



Many of you will have met Dean at our various events and witnessed his fantastic commitment and enthusiasm at first hand.
